

30th Annual East Coast Classic 2022

Covid Protocols for Venue - PG County Sports and Learning Complex (Sportsplex)



Fairland Gymnastics is hosting the **East Coast Classic** on February 18-20, 2022 at PG County's Sports and Learning Complex. The Sportsplex administration has adjusted their rules of usage and implemented COVID restrictions and protocols to ensure the safety of their employees, patrons, and athletic participants. Judges, coaches, athletes, and spectators attending the 2022 East Coast Classic hosted by Fairland Gymnastics are **REQUIRED** to follow all of Sportsplex' guidelines and rules. Failure to do so will lead to removal of the person from the venue.

Please thoroughly read through the protocols and share with all spectators. The Covid protocols as well as other information about the ECC will also be posted on our meet website at www.fairlandgymnastics.com

1. **MASKS MUST BE WORN** by spectators, coaches, judges, officials, and athletes (when they are not competing on the apparatus) **AT ALL TIMES**.
2. There are **CAPACITY LIMITS** on the main competition area as well as spectator area. **2 spectators per gymnasts** are allowed (the number is including EVERYONE, no matter if the second person is a child, a baby, or another adult).
3. **PROOF OF VACCINATION OR NEGATIVE PCR COVID 19 TEST** (rapid tests are NOT acceptable) within 72 hours of the event **AND** a valid, current **IDENTIFICATION** is **REQUIRED** for entrance to the venue (this includes all judges, coaches, and spectators of any age, except for under 2-year-olds and competing athletes. Infants and toddlers under 2 and participating gymnasts will not need a test or proof of vaccination.) Please **PLAN AHEAD** if you are taking the PCR test as you may need an appointment and it can take several days to get results.
4. The actual vaccination card, a picture of the card, a print out or online version of the PCR test results are all **acceptable forms of proof**. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
5. ALL SPECTATORS (including children, toddlers, and infants) need to have a **PRE-PURCHASED WRISTBAND**. The wristbands will be purchased from Fairland Gymnastics by the participating gym with the rule of 2 spectators per gymnast. Fairland Gymnastics will send the number of purchased wrist bands to the participating gyms prior to the event once payment is received. The participating gym is responsible to have parents pay them back for the wristbands needed for entry and will also hand them out to their parents or friends who plan to attend the ECC. There will be **NO** admission without the pre-purchased wristbands and **NO EXTRAS** will be sold at the event. Wristbands need to be worn visibly when spectators come in.
6. Upon entering the building, spectators, gymnasts, and coaches will follow the **signs** to be directed to the correct areas.
7. **NO FOOD or DRINK** is allowed in the competition and spectator area. Coaches and judges will be provided with a boxed meal and water in a separate area.
8. This year's awards will be held in the main competition area.
